

Small group study This year, Solid Ground launched a new kind of study that focuses on small group discussion instead of our typical classroom type course. The study, entitled "The Call to Discipleship", was birthed out of John Gould's one day seminar of the same name. The first two courses, one evening and one daytime, were run during the fall semester with a total of ten students, with each group being a good size to facilitate discussion. The course was very well received by the students, with most expressing that they came away with a much better understanding of what discipleship is truly meant to look like. It is our hope to continue offering the course at Solid Ground as well as at area churches, with our students taking the initiative to introduce the course to their congregations. We also desire to see individuals utilize the study as a personal devotional. Plans are also being initiated to publicize the course through our website in 2020.

2019 fundraisers

This year SGM held three very successful fundraisers which generated over \$4,000.00 in revenue for the ministry.

Gift Card Sales: Generated \$865.30 in profit with the sale of 554 gift cards in various denominations and vendors.

Mint Smoothies: This year we ordered two extra cases and sold the majority totaling \$667.53. The remainder (\$224) will be sold in January classes.

Christmas Bazaar & Silent Auction: SGM welcomed 15 vendors, had 19 items donated to the silent auction and approx. 130 visitors came to the event. The total profit was \$2500.00.
