Mark 1:35

In the early morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left *the house*, and went away to a secluded place, and was praying there.

Luke 5:16

But Jesus Himself would *often* slip away to the wilderness and pray.

1 Peter 2:21

For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps,

Matthew 11:29

Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS.

When did Jesus pray?

Mark 1:35

In the early morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left *the house*, and went away to a secluded place, and was praying there.

Matthew 14:19

Ordering the people to sit down on the grass, He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up toward heaven, He blessed *the food*, and breaking the loaves He gave them to the disciples, and the disciples *gave them* to the crowds,

Luke 24:30-31

30. When He had reclined *at the table* with them, He took the bread and blessed *it*, and breaking *it*, He *began* giving *it* to them.

31. Then their eyes were opened and they recognized Him; and He vanished from their sight.

Luke 6:12-13

12. It was at this time that He went off to the mountain to pray, and He spent the whole night in prayer to God.

13. And when day came, He called His disciples to Him and chose twelve of them, whom He also named as apostles:

Luke 3:21-22

21. Now when all the people were baptized, Jesus was also baptized, and while He was praying, heaven was opened,

22. and the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in bodily form like a dove, and a voice came out of heaven, "You are My beloved Son, in You I am well-pleased."

When did Jesus pray? cont'd

Luke 9:18-22

18. And it happened that while He was praying alone, the disciples were with Him, and He questioned them, saying, "Who do the people say that I am?"
19. They answered and said, "John the Baptist, and others say Elijah; but others, that one of the prophets of old has risen again."
20. And He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" And Peter answered and said, "The Christ of God."
21. But He warned them and instructed *them* not to tell this to anyone,
22. saying, "The Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed and be raised up on the third day."

Luke 9:28-29

28. Some eight days after these sayings, He took along Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray.
29. And while He was praying, the appearance of His face became different, and His clothing *became* white *and* gleaming.

Luke 11:1

It happened that while Jesus was praying in a certain place, after He had finished, one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray just as John also taught his disciples."

John 11:41-42

41. So they removed the stone. Then Jesus raised His eyes, and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me.
42. "I knew that You always hear Me; but because of the people standing around I said it, so that they may believe that You sent Me."

Matthew 14:21-23

21. There were about five thousand men who ate, besides women and children.
22. Immediately He made the disciples get into the boat and go ahead of *Him* to the other side, while He sent the crowds away.
23. After He had sent the crowds away, He went up on the mountain by Himself to pray; and when it was evening, He was there alone.

John 6:15

So Jesus, perceiving that they were intending to come and take Him by force to make Him king, withdrew again to the mountain by Himself alone.

Mark 3:20

And He came home, and the crowd gathered again, to such an extent that they could not even eat a meal.

Mark 6:31, 46

31. And He said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a secluded place and rest a while." (For there were many *people* coming and going, and they did not even have time to eat.)
...
46. After bidding them farewell, He left for the mountain to pray.

When did Jesus pray? cont'd

Matthew 26:36

Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and said to His disciples, "Sit here while I go over there and pray."

Luke 22:39-41

39. And He came out and proceeded as was His custom to the Mount of Olives; and the disciples also followed Him.

II 40. When He arrived at the place, He said to them, "Pray that you may not enter into temptation."

41. And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and *began* to pray,

Luke 23:34, 46

34. But Jesus was saying, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing." And they cast lots, dividing up His garments among themselves.

...

46. And Jesus, crying out with a loud voice, said, "Father, INTO YOUR HANDS I COMMIT MY SPIRIT." Having said this, He breathed His last.

Where did Jesus pray?

Matthew 14:23

After He had sent the crowds away, He went up on the mountain by Himself to pray; and when it was evening, He was there alone.

Mark 6:46

After bidding them farewell, He left for the mountain to pray.

Luke 6:12

III It was at this time that He went off to the mountain to pray, and He spent the whole night in prayer to God.

John 6:15

So Jesus, perceiving that they were intending to come and take Him by force to make Him king, withdrew again to the mountain by Himself alone.

Mark 1:35

Matthew 26:42

He went away again a second time and prayed, saying, "My Father, if this cannot pass away unless I drink it, Your will be done."

Luke 6:12

It was at this time that He went off to the mountain to pray, and He spent the whole night in prayer to God.

Hebrews 5:7

In the days of His flesh, He offered up both prayers and supplications with loud crying and tears to the One able to save Him from death, and He was heard because of His piety.

Luke 22:44

And being in agony He was praying very fervently; and His sweat became like drops of blood, falling down upon the ground.

Matthew 26:44

And He left them again, and went away and prayed a third time, saying the same thing once more.

Matthew 14:19

Ordering the people to sit down on the grass, He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up toward heaven, He blessed *the food*, and breaking the loaves He gave them to the disciples, and the disciples *gave them* to the crowds,

John 11:41

So they removed the stone. Then Jesus raised His eyes, and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me.

John 17:1

Jesus spoke these things; and lifting up His eyes to heaven, He said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son, that the Son may glorify You,

Matthew 26:39

And He went a little beyond *them*, and fell on His face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will."

Luke 22:41

And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and *began* to pray,

Luke 24:50-51

50. And He led them out as far as Bethany, and He lifted up His hands and blessed them.
51. While He was blessing them, He parted from them and was carried up into heaven.

For whom did Jesus pray?

Matthew 19:13-15

13. Then *some* children were brought to Him so that He might lay His hands on them and pray; and the disciples rebuked them.
14. But Jesus said, "Let the children alone, and do not hinder them from coming to Me; for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."
15. After laying His hands on them, He departed from there.

John 17:9

I ask on their behalf; I do not ask on behalf of the world, but of those whom You have given Me; for they are Yours;

Luke 22:31-32

31. "Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has demanded *permission* to sift you like wheat;
32. but I have prayed for you, that your faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned again, strengthen your brothers."

John 17:20

I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word;

Hebrews 7:25

Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

Romans 8:34

... who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.
