

Taking the Bible In – Pt 1

1	<p><u>Luke 11:27-28</u> 27. While Jesus was saying these things, one of the women in the crowd raised her voice and said to Him, "Blessed is the womb that bore You and the breasts at which You nursed." 28. But He said, "On the contrary, blessed are those who hear the word of God and observe it."</p> <p><u>Romans 10:17</u> So faith <i>comes</i> from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.</p> <p><u>1 Timothy 4:13</u> Until I come, give attention to the <i>public reading of Scripture</i>, to exhortation and teaching.</p>
2	<p><u>Matthew 19:3-4</u> 3. <i>Some</i> Pharisees came to Jesus, testing Him and asking, "Is it lawful <i>for a man</i> to divorce his wife for any reason at all?" 4. And He answered and said, "Have you not read that He who created <i>them</i> from the beginning MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE,</p> <p><u>Mark 12:10</u> "Have you not even read this Scripture: 'THE STONE WHICH THE BUILDERS REJECTED, THIS BECAME THE CHIEF CORNER <i>stone</i>;</p> <p><u>Revelation 1:3</u> Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of the prophecy, and heed the things which are written in it; for the time is near.</p>
3	<p><u>Psalms 119:11</u> Your word I have treasured in my heart, That I may not sin against You.</p> <p><u>Psalms 37:31</u> 30. The mouth of the righteous utters wisdom, And his tongue speaks justice. 31. The law of his God is in his heart; His steps do not slip.</p> <p><u>Proverbs 4:4</u> Then he taught me and said to me, "Let your heart hold fast my words; Keep my commandments and live;</p> <p><u>Deuteronomy 11:18</u> "You shall therefore impress these words of mine on your heart and on your soul; and you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontals on your forehead.</p>
