## Why is it important to study prophecy?

- 1. A knowledge of prophecy is essential to understanding the Bible
  - a) Bible literacy is at an all-time low
  - **b)** 23 of 27 NT books
  - c) 1 in 30 NT verses \rightarrow refer(s) to the coming of Jesus
  - d) 21 times Jesus
  - e) for every mention of Jesus' 1st coming there are eight of the 2nd
  - f) over 50 times believers are exhorted to be ready for His coming
  - g) prophecy and its fulfillment prove the Bible's truth and reliability
- 2. Prophecy demonstrates the centrality and supremacy of Jesus Christ
- **3.** Prophecy proves that God is the true God and that He is in control of everything that happens. This gives us peace of mind

- **4.** Prophecy has some practical benefits! It encourages us to:
  - a) live by faith  $\rightarrow$  living by faith strengthens faith (John 13:19; 14:29)
  - **b)** have an eternal perspective to "lay up treasures in heaven" rather than live for earthly pleasures (Matthew 6:19-20)
  - c) remember that we will stand before the Judgment Seat of Christ
  - **d)** purify ourselves; to live holy and godly (2 Cor. 5:9-10; Tit. 2:11-14; 1 Jo. 3:3)
  - **e)** have hope in a hopeless age (Heb. 11:1; Rom. 8:24-25; 1 Jo. 3:2-3)
  - f) encourage one another (Heb. 10:25)
  - g) comfort one another (1 Thess. 4:13-18)
- 5. Prophecy protects us from false teachers and their heresies (Matt. 24:4-5)
- **6.** Prophecy is a powerful tool for sharing the gospel of salvation
