## Sequence of Events

# $#726 - \underline{harpaz\bar{o}} = \text{``caught up''}$

- = to seize, carry off by force
- = to seize, to claim for oneself eagerly
- = to snatch out, snatch away

"Harpazō" is used of <u>divine</u>
<a href="mailto:bower"><u>power</u> transferring a person</a>
marvelously and swiftly from one
place to another - Thayer's Lexicon

### The Rapture is:

- the coming of the Lord
- a resurrection
- a reunion

## Timing: "pre-tribulation"

- 1. Imminence the rapture is an event that could happen at any moment.
- The 70 weeks are for Israel and Jerusalem. The Church began after the 69<sup>th</sup> week and will be raptured before the 70<sup>th</sup> week begins. Israel and the Church are distinct.
- 3. The Church is not destined for wrath
- 4. We are to comfort one another with the truth of the rapture. There is no comfort in waiting for wrath.
- 5. The "restrainer", the Holy Spirit, as He indwells the Church must be taken away before the Antichrist can be revealed.

- 1 Thess. 4:16 The Lord Jesus Himself will descend
  - :14 God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep in Jesus = souls / spirits
    - :16 from heaven with:
    - a shout = cry of command, verbal signal
    - the voice of the archangel Michael
    - the trumpet of God
    - (1 Cor. 15:52) at the last trumpet (John 14:1-3) Jesus will receive us to Himself
- 2 :16 The dead in Christ will rise first = bodies
  - will be raised imperishable (1 Cor. 15:52)
- 3 :17 Together with them, those who are alive:
  - will be caught up in the clouds
  - will meet the Lord Jesus in the air.
- 4 (1 Corinthians 15:50-58) We will all be changed
  - we will put on an immortal and imperishable body
  - like Jesus' glorious body (Phil. 3:21)
  - in a moment = an instant so brief it is indivisible
  - in the twinkling of an eye
  - at the last trumpet
    - → flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God
- (John 14:1-3) So that we may be where He is
   He will bring us to His Father's house, to the place He has prepared for us = the New Jerusalem

   :17 So we shall always be with the Lord
