THE IMPORTANCE OF KNOWING GOD

Jeremiah 9:23-24

- 5. Thus says the LORD, "Let not a wise man boast of his wisdom, and let not the mighty man boast of his might, let not a rich man boast of his riches;
- 6. but let him who boasts boast of this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD who exercises lovingkindness, justice and righteousness on earth; for I delight in these things," declares the LORD.

1 Kings 8:27

"But will God indeed dwell on the earth? Behold, heaven and the highest heaven cannot contain You, how much less this house which I have built!

<u>Job 9:10</u>

Who does great things, unfathomable, and wondrous works without number.

<u>Isaiah 55:8</u>

"For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways," declares the LORD.

1 Timothy 6:13-16

- **13.** I charge you in the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who testified the good confession before Pontius Pilate,
- 14. that you keep the commandment without stain or reproach until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 15. which He will bring about at the proper time—He who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords,
- 16. who alone possesses immortality and dwells in unapproachable light, whom no man has seen or can see. To Him *be* honor and eternal dominion! Amen.

Romans 11:33-34

- **33.** Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways!
- 34. For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who became His counselor?

Isaiah 44:18

They do not know, nor do they understand, for He has smeared over their eyes so that they cannot see and their hearts so that they cannot comprehend.

The heavens are telling of the glory of God; and their expanse is declaring the work of His hands.

- 3. And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

Luke 24:25-27

- 25. And He said to them, "O foolish men and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken!
- 26. "Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things and to enter into His glory?"
- 27. Then beginning with Moses and with all the prophets, He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.

John 17:3

This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

Jeremiah 31:34

"They will not teach again, each man his neighbor and each man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them," declares the LORD, "for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."

Jeremiah 24:7

14. "I am the good shepherd, and I know My own and My own know Me,

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God

John 14:7-9

- 7. "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; from now on you know Him, and have seen Him."
- 8. Philip *said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us."
- 9. Jesus *said to him, "Have I been so long with you, and *yet* you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how *can* you say, 'Show us the Father'?

2 Peter 3:17-18

- 17. You therefore, beloved, knowing this beforehand, be on your guard so that you are not carried away by the error of unprincipled men and fall from your own steadfastness,
- **18.** but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him *be* the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.

Exodus 5:2

But Pharaoh said, "Who is the LORD that I should obey His voice to let Israel go? I do not know the LORD, and besides, I will not let Israel go."

<u>1 John 2:3-4</u>

- 3. By this we know that we have come to know Him, if we keep His commandments.
- 4. The one who says, "I have come to know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him;

1 Kings 8:43

... hear in heaven Your dwelling place, and do according to all for which the foreigner calls to You, in order that all the peoples of the earth may know Your name, to fear You, as *do* Your people Israel, and that they may know that this house which I have built is called by Your name.

1 Chronicles 28:9

As for you, my son Solomon, know the God of your father, and serve Him with a whole heart and a willing mind; for the LORD searches all hearts, and understands every intent of the thoughts. If you seek Him, He will let you find Him; but if you forsake Him, He will reject you forever.

... that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him.

Proverbs 9:10

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

Colossians 1:9-12

- 9. For this reason also, since the day we heard *of it*, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding,
- **10.** so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please *Him* in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;
- 11. strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for the attaining of all steadfastness and patience; joyously
- 12. giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light.

Ephesians 4:13

... until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.

2 Peter 1:2-3

- 2. Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord;
- 3. seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.

Deuteronomy 29:29

The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but the things revealed belong to us and to our sons forever, that we may observe all the words of this law.

Proverbs 2:1-6

- 1. My son, if you will receive my words and treasure my commandments within you,
- 2. Make your ear attentive to wisdom, incline your heart to understanding;
- 3. For if you cry for discernment, lift your voice for understanding;
- 4. If you seek her as silver and search for her as for hidden treasures;
- 5. Then you will discern the fear of the LORD and discover the knowledge of God.
- 6. For the LORD gives wisdom; from His mouth *come* knowledge and understanding.

Philippians 3:8-10

- 8. More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ,
- 9. and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from *the* Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which *comes* from God on the basis of faith,
- 10. that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death;
