May it also be the basis for holy living 8. There is a future, final "day of wrath" - complaining/grumbling against the Lord for each of us to the glory of God! and righteous judgment coming; (Num. 11:1, 14:27) unprecedented tribulation and distress in which God's wrath will be finished 3.
