# **GOD IS RIGHTEOUS - WRATH**

#### 2 Chronicles 34:25

"Because they have forsaken Me and have burned incense to other gods, that they might provoke Me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore My wrath will be poured out on this place and it shall not be quenched."

#### <u>John 3:36</u>

"He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

# Romans 2:5-8

- 5. But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God,
- 6. who WILL RENDER TO EACH PERSON ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS:
- 7. to those who by perseverance in doing good seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life;
- 8. but to those who are selfishly ambitious and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, wrath and indignation.

#### Ephesians 5:6

Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.

#### Deuteronomy 9:7

Remember, do not forget how you provoked the LORD your God to wrath in the wilderness; from the day that you left the land of Egypt until you arrived at this place, you have been rebellious against the LORD.

#### Jude 1:14-16

- 14. It was also about these men that Enoch, in the seventh generation from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord came with many thousands of His holy ones,
- 15. to execute judgment upon all, and to convict all the ungodly of all their ungodly deeds which they have done in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."
- 16. These are grumblers, finding fault, following after their own lusts; they speak arrogantly, flattering people for the sake of gaining an advantage.

#### Matthew 23:27-28

- 27. "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which on the outside appear beautiful, but inside they are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness.
- 28. "So you, too, outwardly appear righteous to men, but inwardly you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness.

#### <u>Isaiah 13:11</u>

Thus I will punish the world for its evil and the wicked for their iniquity; I will also put an end to the arrogance of the proud and abase the haughtiness of the ruthless.

# Numbers 11:1

Now the people became like those who complain of adversity in the hearing of the LORD; and when the LORD heard it, His anger was kindled, and the fire of the LORD burned among them and consumed some of the outskirts of the camp.

# Numbers 14:27

How long shall I bear with this evil congregation who are grumbling against Me? I have heard the complaints of the sons of Israel, which they are making against Me.

# <u>Joshua 24:19-23</u>

- 19. Then Joshua said to the people, "You will not be able to serve the LORD, for He is a holy God. He is a jealous God; He will not forgive your transgression or your sins.
- 20. "If you forsake the LORD and serve foreign gods, then He will turn and do you harm and consume you after He has done good to you."
- 21. The people said to Joshua, "No, but we will serve the LORD."
- 22. Joshua said to the people, "You are witnesses against yourselves that you have chosen for yourselves the LORD, to serve Him." And they said, "We are witnesses."
- 23. "Now therefore, put away the foreign gods which are in your midst, and incline your hearts to the LORD, the God of Israel."

# Romans 1:16-18

- 16. For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
- 17. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "BUT THE RIGHTEOUS man SHALL LIVE BY FAITH."
- 18. For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

#### . <u>Nahum 1:3</u>

The LORD is slow to anger and great in power, and the LORD will by no means leave the guilty unpunished. In whirlwind and storm is His way, and clouds are the dust beneath His feet.

# Luke 13:6-9

- 6. And He began telling this parable: "A man had a fig tree which had been planted in his vineyard; and he came looking for fruit on it and did not find any.
- 7. "And he said to the vineyard-keeper, 'Behold, for three years I have come looking for fruit on this fig tree without finding any. Cut it down! Why does it even use up the ground?'
- 8. "And he answered and said to him, 'Let it alone, sir, for this year too, until I dig around it and put in fertilizer;
- 9. and if it bears fruit next year, fine; but if not, cut it down." "

# Numbers 32:13

So the LORD's anger burned against Israel, and He made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until the entire generation of those who had done evil in the sight of the LORD was destroyed.

#### Jeremiah 15:15

You who know, O LORD, remember me, take notice of me, and take vengeance for me on my persecutors. Do not, in view of Your patience, take me away; know that for Your sake I endure reproach.

#### Romans 2:5

#### Ezekiel 6:9-10

- 9. Then those of you who escape will remember Me among the nations to which they will be carried captive, how I have been hurt by their adulterous hearts which turned away from Me, and by their eyes which played the harlot after their idols; and they will loathe themselves in their own sight for the evils which they have committed, for all their abominations.
- 10. Then they will know that I am the LORD; I have not said in vain that I would inflict this disaster on them." '

#### Zechariah 10:9

When I scatter them among the peoples, They will remember Me in far countries, And they with their children will live and come back.

#### <u>Amos 4:9-11</u>

- 9. "I smote you with scorching wind and mildew; and the caterpillar was devouring Your many gardens and vineyards, fig trees and olive trees; yet you have not returned to Me," declares the LORD.
- 10. "I sent a plague among you after the manner of Egypt; I slew your young men by the sword along with your captured horses, and I made the stench of your camp rise up in your nostrils; yet you have not returned to Me," declares the LORD.
- 11. "I overthrew you, as God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah, and you were like a firebrand snatched from a blaze; yet you have not returned to Me," declares the LORD.

#### Ezekiel 38:22-23

- 22. With pestilence and with blood I will enter into judgment with him; and I will rain on him and on his troops, and on the many peoples who are with him, a torrential rain, with hailstones, fire and brimstone.
- 23. I will magnify Myself, sanctify Myself, and make Myself known in the sight of many nations; and they will know that I am the LORD." '

# Romans 2:5

# Revelation 15:1

Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous, seven angels who had seven plagues, which are the last, because in them the wrath of God is finished.

#### <u>Isaiah 53:5-6</u>

- 5. But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed.
- 6. All of us like sheep have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; but the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him.

#### 1 Peter 2:24-25

- 24. and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.
- 25. For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls.

# Romans 3:24-26

- 24. being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;
- 25. whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;
- 26. for the demonstration, I say, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

# <u>1 John 4:10</u>

In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

# 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10

- 24. For they themselves report about us what kind of a reception we had with you, and how you turned to God from idols to serve a living and true God,
- 25. and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, that is Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath to come.

# Romans 5:9

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.
