John 4:24

"God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

Acts 17:24

2 Corinthians 5:18-20

18. Now all *these* things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation,
19. namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation.
20. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

Isaiah 43:10

Isaiah 44:6

Isaiah 48:16

"Come near to Me, listen to this: from the first I have not spoken in secret, from the time it took place, I was there. And now the Lord GOD has sent Me, and His Spirit."

Isaiah 61:1

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives and freedom to prisoners;

John 14:16-17

16. "I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever;
17. *that is* the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, *but* you know Him because He abides with you and will be in you.

Luke 22:42

saying, “Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Yours be done.”

John 5:36

“But the testimony which I have is greater than *the testimony of John*; for the works which the Father has given Me to accomplish—the very works that I do—testify about Me, that the Father has sent Me.

1 John 4:14

We have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son *to be* the Savior of the world.

John 14:26

“But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

John 15:26

7. “But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.

13. “But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

14. “He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose *it* to you.

1 Corinthians 8:6

yet for us there is *but* one God, the Father, from whom are all things and we *exist* for Him; and one Lord, Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we *exist* through Him.

John 1:3

All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

Colossians 1:16-17

16. For by Him all things were created, *both* in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him.

17. He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.

Psalms 104:24, 30

24. O LORD, how many are Your works! In wisdom You have made them all; the earth is full of Your possessions.

Revelation 1:1

The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His bond-servants, the things which must soon take place; and He sent and communicated *it* by His angel to His bond-servant John,

John 1:1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 16:12-15

12. “I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now.
13. “But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.
14. “He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose *it* to you.
15. “All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose *it* to you.

Ephesians 3:4-5

4. By referring to this, when you read you can understand my insight into the mystery of Christ,
5. which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit;

2 Peter 1:21

for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

John 3:16-17

16. “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.
17. “For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.

2 Corinthians 5:19
