God is holy - unique, transcendent distinct, separate far above and beyond us having no equals or rivals among "gods" in a class by Himself (Ps. 99:1-3; Ex. 15:11; Isa. 40:25; 1 Sam. 2:2; Ps. 86:8-10) 2. God is holy - morally perfectly pure totally free of evil, sin or darkness (Hab. 1:13a; 1 John 1:5) 3 God is holy - holiness is not one attribute all His attributes are holy every aspect of His being is holy 4.
