The SIGNIFICANCE of Christ's DEATH ~ Pt. 2

1 Corinthians 1:18

For the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

17 <u>Romans 1:16</u>

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Isaiah 53:5-6

- 5. But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed.
- 6. All of us like sheep have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; but the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him.

18 <u>1 Peter 2:24-25</u>

- 24. and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.
- 25. For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls.

Ephesians 1:7

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

Matthew 26:28

... for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.

19 Isaiah 43:25

"I, even I, am the one who wipes out your transgressions for My own sake, and I will not remember your sins.

Psalm 103:12

As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us.

Hebrews 9:13-14

- 13. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling those who have been defiled sanctify for the cleansing of the flesh,
- 14. how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

20 Hebrews 9:9-10

- 9. which *is* a symbol for the present time. Accordingly both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make the worshiper perfect in conscience,
- 10. since they *relate* only to food and drink and various washings, regulations for the body imposed until a time of reformation.

Romans 5:9

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath *of God* through Him.

Romans 3:24

21 ... being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

Romans 4:5

But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness,

Revelation 1:5-6

- 5. ... and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who loves us and released us from our sins by His blood—
- 6. and He has made us *to be* a kingdom, priests to His God and Father—to Him *be* the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

22 John 8:34

Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who commits sin is the slave of sin.

<u>1 John 3:6</u>

No one who abides in Him sins; no one who sins has seen Him or knows Him.

Hebrews 2:14-15

14. Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of

the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil,

15. and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives.

<u>John 3:16</u>

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

24 <u>1 Corinthians 2:9</u>

... but just as it is written, "THINGS WHICH EYE HAS NOT SEEN AND EAR HAS NOT HEARD, AND ENTERED THE HEART OF MAN, ALL THAT GOD HAS PREPARED FOR THOSE WHO LOVE HIM."

Galatians 1:4

... who gave Himself for our sins so that He might rescue us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,

Hebrews 2:14

25 Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil,

<u>1 John 5:18</u>

We know that no one who is born of God sins; but He who was born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him.

Philippians 2:8

Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Romans 5:19

26 For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, even so through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous.

2 Corinthians 5:21

He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Romans 6:5

For if we have become united with *Him* in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be *in the likeness* of His resurrection,

<u>1 Peter 2:24</u>

27 ...and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

Romans 6:13

... and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin *as* instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members *as* instruments of righteousness to God.

Romans 7:4

Therefore, my brethren, you also were made to die to the Law through the body of Christ, so that you might be joined to another, to Him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit for God.

Romans 6:14

For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

2 Corinthians 5:15

29 ... and He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf.

1 Peter 1:18-19

30

18. knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers,

19. but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, *the blood* of Christ.

31 <u>I Corinthians 5:7</u> Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are *in fact* unleavened. For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed. <u>Titus 2:14</u> ... who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

Ephesians 2:10

Hebrews 10:14

32 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.

Matthew 5:16

Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

33 Ephesians 2:8

For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God;

Jeremiah 32:40

I will make an everlasting covenant with them that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; and I will put the fear of Me in their hearts so that they will not turn away from Me.

1 Peter 2:19-21

- 19. For this *finds* favor, if for the sake of conscience toward God a person bears up under sorrows when suffering unjustly.
- 20. For what credit is there if, when you sin and are harshly treated, you endure it with patience? But if when you do what is right and suffer *for it* you patiently endure it, this *finds* favor with God.
- 21. For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps,

34 Philippians 2:5-8

- 5. Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,
- 6. who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,
- 7. but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men.
- 8. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Ephesians 5:25-27

25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, 26 so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, 27 that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless.

35 Colossians 1:22

... yet He has now reconciled you in His fleshly body through death, in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach—

Ephesians 1:4

... just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love
