John 1:1-2, 14

- 1. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- 2. He was in the beginning with God.

14. And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

1 Peter 2:22

(Christ) WHO COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND IN HIS MOUTH;

<u>John 10:17–18</u>

- 17. "For this reason the Father loves Me, because I lay down My life so that I may take it again.
- 18. "No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This commandment I received from My Father."

Acts 2:22-23

1

- 22. "Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God performed through Him in your midst, just as you yourselves know—
- 23. this *Man*, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put *Him* to death.

Isaiah 53:10

But the LORD was pleased to crush Him, putting *Him* to grief; if He would render Himself *as* a guilt offering, He will see *His* offspring, He will prolong *His* days, and the good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand.

2 Timothy 1:9

(*God*) who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity,

Isaiah 53:10 (see above)

Ephesians 5:2

... and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

John 10:11

I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.

Acts 20:28

Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

Ephesians 5:25

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,

2 Timothy 2:10

For this reason I endure all things for the sake of those who are chosen, so that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus *and* with *it* eternal glory.

Matthew 1:21

She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins.

Isaiah 53:12

Therefore, I will allot Him a portion with the great, and He will divide the booty with the strong; because He poured out Himself to death, and was numbered with the transgressors; yet He Himself bore the sin of many, and interceded for the transgressors.

Matthew 20:28

... just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Matthew 26:28

... for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.

Hebrews 9:28

... so Christ also, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time for salvation without *reference to* sin, to those who eagerly await Him.

2 | Hebrews 9:15

For this reason He is the mediator of a new covenant, so that, since a death has taken place for the redemption of the transgressions that were *committed* under the first covenant, those who have been called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

Romans 5:6

For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.

1 Peter 3:18

For Christ also died for sins once for all, *the* just for *the* unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit;

1 Timothy 2:5-6

- 5. For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,
- 6. who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time.

Hebrews 2:9

But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, *namely*, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone.

1 Timothy 4:10

For it is for this we labor and strive, because we have fixed our hope on the living God, who is the Savior of all men, especially of believers.

Week 10-3

Ephesians 5:2

... and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

Ephesians 5:25

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,

Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

1 Corinthians 15:3

For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

Romans 5:7-8

- 7. For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die.
- 8. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Ephesians 1:7

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

Romans 3:25

... (*Christ Jesus*) whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. *This was* to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;

1 John 4:10

In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.

Romans 8:34

Who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.

1 Peter 3:18

For Christ also died for sins once for all, *the* just for *the* unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit;

Ephesians 2:13

Romans 7:4

Therefore, my brethren, you also were made to die to the Law through the body of Christ, so that you might be joined to another, to Him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit for God.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20

- 19. Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?
- 20. For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.

And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and purchased for God with Your blood *men* from every tribe and tongue and people and nation.

Romans 10:12-13

- 12. For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same *Lord* is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him;
- 13. for "Whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved."

John 11:50-52

- 50. ... nor do you take into account that it is expedient for you that one man die for the people, and that the whole nation not perish."
- 51. Now he did not say this on his own initiative, but being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus was going to die for the nation,
- 52. and not for the nation only, but in order that He might also gather together into one the children of God who are scattered abroad.

I have other sheep, which are not of this fold; I must bring them also, and they will hear My voice; and they will become one flock *with* one shepherd.

John 6:37

All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out.

John 2:19-21

- 50. Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."
- 19. The Jews then said, "It took forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?"
- 20. But He was speaking of the temple of His body.

Matthew 12:6

But I say to you that something greater than the temple is here.

Colossians 2:9

For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form,

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

1 Thessalonians 5:9-10

- 9. For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 10. who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep, we will live together with Him.

2 Corinthians 5:8

... we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.

Philippians 1:21-23

- 21. For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.
- 22. But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose.
- 23. But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for *that* is very much better;

1 John 3:8

... the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

Colossians 2:13-15

- 13. When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions,
- 14. having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.
- 15. When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities, He made a public display of them, having triumphed over them through Him.

Hebrews 2:14

Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil,
