THE GOSPEL OF SO GREAT A SALVATION Week 11 – Significance and Meaning – Pt. 2

17. The death of Jesus is the power of the gospel for salvation to all who believe

(1 Co 1:18: Rom 1:16)

- 18. Jesus died and I was healed from my sin
- 19. Jesus died for me and I received the forgiveness of my sins
 - God removed my sins from me
 - He wiped out my sins and He does not remember them

(Eph 1:7; Mt 26:28; Isa 43:25; Ps 103:12)

- 20. Jesus died and my conscience was cleansed
 - no gift or sacrifice or worship I bring to God could perfect my conscience

(Heb 9:13-14: Heb 9:9-10)

- 21. Jesus' death resulted in my justification
 - His blood cancelled out the guilt of my sin
 - God declared my verdict: "NOT GUILTY"

(Rom 5:9; Rom 3:24; Rom 4:5)

- 22. Jesus' death released me from my sin and from my slavery to sin (Rev 1:5-6; Jn 8:34; 1 Jn 3:6)
- 23. Jesus died and the slavery to the fear of death was broken
 - His death removed the devil's one weapon: unforgiven sin (Heb 2:14-15)

- 24. Jesus died and God gives to all who believe in 30. Jesus died to set me free from all the futile Him eternal life
 - what this fully implies remains to be revealed (In 3:16: 1 Cor 2:9)
- (Isa 53:5-6; 1 Pet 2:24-25) 25. Jesus died to deliver me from this present evil age
 - He rendered the devil powerless
 - the evil one does not touch me

(Gal 1:4; Heb 2:14; 1 Jn 5:18)

- 26. Jesus' death was His obedience that became my righteousness
 - my sin was cancelled out
 - Jesus' righteousness was imputed to me (Phil 2:8; Rom 5:19; 2 Cor 5:21)
- 27. Jesus died and I became united with Him in His death
 - I died to sin and now live to righteousness
 - I use the members of my body as instruments of righteousness

(Rom 6:5; 1 Pet 2:24; Rom 6:13)

- 28. Through Jesus' death, I died to the law in order to bear fruit for God
 - I am not under law but under grace

(Rom 7:4; Rom 6:14)

29. Jesus died that I may no longer live for myself but for Him who died for my sake (2 Cor 5:15)

- ways of my forefathers
 - futility = an empty, meaningless, unprofitable life that ends in destruction (1 Pet 1:18-19)
- 31. Because of Jesus' death
 - I am (now)

- I have been

* being sanctified

*perfected for all time

* cleansing out leaven

* made unleavened (Heb 10:14; 1 Cor 5:7)

- 32. Jesus died so that I, who belong to Him, will be zealous to do good works
 - I was saved not by but for good works
 - my good works glorify my Father in heaven (Titus 2:14; Eph 2:10; Mt 5:16)
- 33. Jesus died to enable me to live by faith in Him
 - God gave me the faith that saved me
 - He will keep me faithful to Him throughout my life (Gal 2:20; Eph 2:8; Jer 32:40)
- 34. Jesus suffered and died in order to leave me an example to follow in His steps
 - I am to have the same attitude of humility and selfless love (1 Pet 2:19-21: Phil 2:5-8)
- 35. Jesus died to present me to Him holy and blameless and above reproach

(Eph 5:25-27: Col 1:22; Eph 1:4)
