


Many Jewish regulations were broken in this process:

- 1. No trials were to be held during Passover week
- 2. Each member of the Sanhedrin was to vote individually
- 3. Jews had no authority to execute a person
- 4. Trials were not to be held at night
- 5. The accused was to be provided representation
