

JESUS' MOTIVATION IN SALVATION – Pt. 4

THE FATHER'S GLORY

John 17:4

I glorified You on the earth, having accomplished the work which You have given Me to do.

1 Peter 4:10–11

10. As each one has received a *special* gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
11. Whoever speaks, *is to do so* as one who is speaking the utterances of God; whoever serves *is to do so* as one who is serving by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

John 14:12–13

12. "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do; because I go to the Father.
13. "Whatever you ask in My name, that will I do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

John 12:23–28

23. And Jesus *answered them, saying, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.
24. "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.
25. "He who loves his life loses it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it to life eternal.
26. "If anyone serves Me, he must follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him.
27. "Now My soul has become troubled; and what shall I say, 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour.
28. "Father, glorify Your name." Then a voice came out of heaven: "I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again."

John 13:31–32

31. Therefore when he had gone out, Jesus *said, "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in Him;
32. if God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and will glorify Him immediately.

John 17:1–5

1. Jesus spoke these things; and lifting up His eyes to heaven, He said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son, that the Son may glorify You,
2. even as You gave Him authority over all flesh, that to all whom You have given Him, He may give eternal life.
3. "This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
4. "I glorified You on the earth, having accomplished the work which You have given Me to do.
5. "Now, Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

John 6:38

For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

Hebrews 10:7

“THEN I SAID, ‘BEHOLD, I HAVE COME (IN THE SCROLL OF THE BOOK IT IS WRITTEN OF ME) TO DO YOUR WILL, O GOD.’ ”

Psalm 40:7-8

7. Then I said, “Behold, I come; In the scroll of the book it is written of me.

8. I delight to do Your will, O my God; Your Law is within my heart.”

John 4:34

Jesus said to them, “My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me and to accomplish His work.

John 5:30

I can do nothing on My own initiative. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is just, because I do not seek My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

John 8:28

So Jesus said, “When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am *He*, and I do nothing on My own initiative, but I speak these things as the Father taught Me.

John 12:49-50

49. “For I did not speak on My own initiative, but the Father Himself who sent Me has given Me a commandment as to what to say and what to speak.

50. “I know that His commandment is eternal life; therefore the things I speak, I speak just as the Father has told Me.”

John 14:10

“Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative, but the Father abiding in Me does His works.

John 8:29

“And He who sent Me is with Me; He has not left Me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to Him.”

Philippians 2:8

Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

John 14:31

... but so that the world may know that I love the Father, I do exactly as the Father commanded Me. Get up, let us go from here.

Luke 2:49

And He said to them, “Why is it that you were looking for Me? Did you not know that I had to be in My Father’s *house*?”

Luke 5:16

But Jesus Himself would *often* slip away to the wilderness and pray.

Luke 6:12

It was at this time that He went off to the mountain to pray, and He spent the whole night in prayer to God.

John 4:34

Jesus *said to them, “My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me and to accomplish His work.

Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Ephesians 5:25

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,

Hebrews 12:1–3

1. Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,
2. fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
3. For consider Him who has endured such hostility by sinners against Himself, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

Deuteronomy 21:22–23

22 “If a man has committed a sin worthy of death and he is put to death, and you hang him on a tree,
23 his corpse shall not hang all night on the tree, but you shall surely bury him on the same day (for he who is hanged is accursed of God), so that you do not defile your land which the LORD your God gives you as an inheritance.

Galatians 3:13

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, “CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE”—
