

GOD’S RESPONSE TO SINNERS – Part 3

Psalm 94:1

O Lord, God of vengeance, God of vengeance, shine forth!

Exodus 20:4–6

4. “You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth.
5. “You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me,
6. but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.

Exodus 34:14

—for you shall not worship any other god, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God—

Deuteronomy 4:24

“For the LORD your God is a consuming fire, a jealous God.

Joshua 24:19–20

19. Then Joshua said to the people, “You will not be able to serve the LORD, for He is a holy God. He is a jealous God; He will not forgive your transgression or your sins.
20. “If you forsake the LORD and serve foreign gods, then He will turn and do you harm and consume you after He has done good to you.”

Jeremiah 5:9, 29

5. “Shall I not punish these *people*,” declares the LORD, “and on a nation such as this shall I not avenge Myself?
...
29. ‘Shall I not punish these *people*?’ declares the LORD, ‘On a nation such as this Shall I not avenge Myself?’

Jeremiah 9:9

“Shall I not punish them for these things?” declares the LORD. “On a nation such as this shall I not avenge Myself?”

Isaiah 63:10

But they rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit; therefore He turned Himself to become their enemy, He fought against them.

Nahum 1:2

A jealous and avenging God is the LORD; the LORD is avenging and wrathful. The LORD takes vengeance on His adversaries, and He reserves wrath for His enemies.

Deuteronomy 32:39-42

- 39.** 'See now that I, I am He, and there is no god besides Me; it is I who put to death and give life. I have wounded and it is I who heal, and there is no one who can deliver from My hand.
40. 'Indeed, I lift up My hand to heaven, and say, as I live forever,
41. If I sharpen My flashing sword, and My hand takes hold on justice, I will render vengeance on My adversaries, and I will repay those who hate Me.
42. 'I will make My arrows drunk with blood, and My sword will devour flesh, with the blood of the slain and the captives, from the long-haired leaders of the enemy.'

Deuteronomy 7:9-10

- 9.** "Know therefore that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God, who keeps His covenant and His lovingkindness to a thousandth generation with those who love Him and keep His commandments;
10. but repays those who hate Him to their faces, to destroy them; He will not delay with him who hates Him, He will repay him to his face.

Isaiah 1:24

Therefore the Lord GOD of hosts, the Mighty One of Israel, declares, "Ah, I will be relieved of My adversaries and avenge Myself on My foes.

Romans 12:19

Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath of God, for it is written, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY," says the Lord.

Hebrews 10:30-31

- 30.** For we know Him who said, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY." And again, "THE LORD WILL JUDGE HIS PEOPLE."
31. It is a terrifying thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

Ephesians 2:12, 19

- 12.** *remember* that you were at that time separate from Christ, excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.
...
19. So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household,

Ephesians 4:18

... being darkened in their understanding, excluded from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their heart;

Proverbs 15:29

The LORD is far from the wicked, but He hears the prayer of the righteous.

Isaiah 59:1-2

- 1.** Behold, the LORD'S hand is not so short that it cannot save; nor is His ear so dull that it cannot hear.
2. But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear.

Romans 1:18-32 (see Bible)

Genesis 3:16–19

16. To the woman He said, "I will greatly multiply your pain in childbirth, in pain you will bring forth children; yet your desire will be for your husband, and he will rule over you."
17. Then to Adam He said, "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat from it'; cursed is the ground because of you; in toil you will eat of it all the days of your life.
18. "Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you; and you will eat the plants of the field;
19. By the sweat of your face you will eat bread, till you return to the ground, because from it you were taken; for you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

Job 7:1–3

1. "Is not man forced to labor on earth, and *are not* his days like the days of a hired man?
2. "As a slave who pants for the shade, and as a hired man who eagerly waits for his wages,
3. So am I allotted months of vanity, and nights of trouble are appointed me.

Ecclesiastes 2:22–23

22. For what does a man get in all his labor and in his striving with which he labors under the sun?
23. Because all his days his task is painful and grievous; even at night his mind does not rest. This too is vanity.

Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Deuteronomy 32:39

See now that I, I am He, and there is no god besides Me; it is I who put to death and give life. I have wounded and it is I who heal, and there is no one who can deliver from My hand.

Job 14:5

Since his days are determined, the number of his months is with You; and his limits You have set so that he cannot pass.

Psalms 139:16

Your eyes have seen my unformed substance; and in Your book were all written the days that were ordained *for me*, when as yet there was not one of them.

Revelation 20:11–15

11. Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them.
12. And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *the book of life*; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.
13. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one *of them* according to their deeds.
14. Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire.
15. And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

2 Thessalonians 1:6-9

6. For after all it is *only* just for God to repay with affliction those who afflict you,
7. and *to give* relief to you who are afflicted and to us as well when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire,
8. dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.
9. These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power,

2 Thessalonians 1:10

... when He comes to be glorified in His saints on that day, and to be marveled at among all who have believed—for our testimony to you was believed.

Matthew 7:23

"And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'

Isaiah 30:33

For Topheth has long been ready, indeed, it has been prepared for the king. He has made it deep and large, a pyre of fire with plenty of wood; the breath of the LORD, like a torrent of brimstone, sets it afire.

Matthew 5:22

"But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be guilty before the court; and whoever says to his brother, 'You good-for-nothing,' shall be guilty before the supreme court; and whoever says, 'You fool,' shall be guilty *enough to go* into the fiery hell.

Mark 9:43

"If your hand causes you to stumble, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life crippled, than, having your two hands, to go into hell, into the unquenchable fire,

Luke 16:28

... for I have five brothers—in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.'

Revelation 20:10

And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Matthew 25:46

"These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

Luke 13:28

In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, but yourselves being thrown out.

Revelation 14:9-11

9. Then another angel, a third one, followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives a mark on his forehead or on his hand,
10. he also will drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is mixed in full strength in the cup of His anger; and he will be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.
11. "And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever; they have no rest day and night, those who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name."

Matthew 8:11–12

- 11.** “I say to you that many will come from east and west, and recline *at the table* with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven;
12. but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.”

Jude 13

... wild waves of the sea, casting up their own shame like foam; wandering stars, for whom the black darkness has been reserved forever.

Matthew 10:28

“Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

Luke 12:5

“But I will warn you whom to fear: fear the One who, after He has killed, has authority to cast into hell; yes, I tell you, fear Him!

1 Thessalonians 4:13

But we do not want you to be uninformed, brethren, about those who are asleep, so that you will not grieve as do the rest who have no hope.

Matthew 5:29–30

- 29.** “If your right eye makes you stumble, tear it out and throw it from you; for it is better for you to lose one of the parts of your body, than for your whole body to be thrown into hell.
30. “If your right hand makes you stumble, cut it off and throw it from you; for it is better for you to lose one of the parts of your body, than for your whole body to go into hell.

Matthew 18:9

“If your eye causes you to stumble, pluck it out and throw it from you. It is better for you to enter life with one eye, than to have two eyes and be cast into the fiery hell.

Mark 9:43–47

- 43.** “If your hand causes you to stumble, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life crippled, than, having your two hands, to go into hell, into the unquenchable fire,
44. [where THEIR WORM DOES NOT DIE, AND THE FIRE IS NOT QUENCHED.]
45. “If your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life lame, than, having your two feet, to be cast into hell,
46. [where THEIR WORM DOES NOT DIE, AND THE FIRE IS NOT QUENCHED.]
47. “If your eye causes you to stumble, throw it out; it is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye, than, having two eyes, to be cast into hell,

Romans 1:16

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Ephesians 1:13

In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise,
