- 7. because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able *to do so*,
- 8. and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

<u>John 6:44</u>

No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day.

Romans 6:23

... For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Ezekiel 18:4

Behold, all souls are Mine; the soul of the father as well as the soul of the son is Mine. The soul who sins will die.

2 Thessalonians 1:8-9

- 8. ... dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.
- 9. These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power,

How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God! And the children of men take refuge in the shadow of Your wings.

Psalm 106:1

Praise the Lord! Oh give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His lovingkindness is everlasting.

1 Chronicles 16:34

O give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His lovingkindness is everlasting.

<u>Psalm 86:5</u>

For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, and abundant in lovingkindness to all who call upon You.

Psalm 145:8

The Lord is gracious and merciful; slow to anger and great in lovingkindness.

<u>Titus 3:5</u>

He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,

<u>Isaiah 63:9</u>

In all their affliction He was afflicted, and the angel of His presence saved them; in His love and in His mercy He redeemed them, and He lifted them and carried them all the days of old.

Psalm 145:8

The Lord is gracious and merciful; slow to anger and great in lovingkindness.

Jeremiah 3:12

Go and proclaim these words toward the north and say, 'Return, faithless Israel,' declares the Lord; 'I will not look upon you in anger. For I am gracious,' declares the Lord; 'I will not be angry forever.

Psalm 25:11

For Your name's sake, O Lord, Pardon my iniquity, for it is great.

<u>Psalm 4:1</u>

Answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have relieved me in my distress; be gracious to me and hear my prayer.

Exodus 15:11

"Who is like You among the gods, O Lord? Who is like You, majestic in holiness, awesome in praises, working wonders?

Proverbs 9:10

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

<u>Psalm 5:4</u>

For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness; no evil dwells with You.

Psalm 92:15

To declare that the Lord is upright; *He is* my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.

<u>1 John 1:5</u>

This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.

2 Chronicles 12:6

So the princes of Israel and the king humbled themselves and said, "The Lord is righteous."

<u>Psalm 33:5</u>

He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the lovingkindness of the Lord.

<u>Psalm 45:6</u>

Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; a scepter of uprightness is the scepter of Your kingdom.

Deuteronomy 10:17

For the Lord your God is the God of gods and the Lord of lords, the great, the mighty, and the awesome God who does not show partiality nor take a bribe.

Deuteronomy 32:4

The Rock! His work is perfect, for all His ways are just; a God of faithfulness and without injustice, righteous and upright is He.

Isaiah 61:8

For I, the Lord, love justice, I hate robbery in the burnt offering; and I will faithfully give them their recompense and make an everlasting covenant with them.

Genesis 18:25

- 5. Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,
- 6. who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,
- 7. but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men.
- 8. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Acts 2:23

... this *Man*, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put Him to death.

2 Corinthians 5:21

He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Galatians 3:13

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE"—

Matthew 27:46

About the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "ELI, ELI, LAMA SABACHTHANI?" that is, "MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?"

Romans 3:23-26

- 23. for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
- 24. being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;
- 25. whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. *This was* to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;
- 26. for the demonstration, *I say*, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.
