He needs anything (Ps. 50:10-12; Acts 17:24-25) 2. mankind is worthy or deserving (Rom. 1:18-32) <p>BUT because of:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>HIS GLORY</u></p> <p>Definitions:</p> <p>Hebrew: 3519 כְּבוֹד <i>kavod</i> = weight, heaviness = splendour, radiance</p> <p>Greek: 1391 δόξα <i>doxa</i> = a correct opinion, estimate = full recognition → praise, honour</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - all of creation declares the glory of God (Ps. 19:1; 97:6; Isa 40:12) - He will not give His glory to another (Isa. 48:11) 	<p>For His glory God</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - made Israel to serve Him (Isa. 43:6-7, 49:3; Jer. 13:11) - rescued Israel from Egypt (Ps. 106:7-8) - raised Pharaoh up (Rom. 9:17) - defeated Pharaoh at the Red Sea (Exo. 14:4, 18) - spared Israel in the wilderness (Eze. 20:14) - gave Israel victory in Canaan (2 Sam. 7:23) - does not forsake Israel (1 Sam. 12:20,22) - gathers and restores Israel from exile (Eze. 36:22-23) - will fill the earth with the knowledge of His glory (Hab. 2:14) 	<p>Jesus, equal with the Father:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - willingly left heaven - was conceived by the Holy Spirit in the womb of a virgin - was born fully God & fully man - walked in perfect obedience - was rejected by men and in the fullness of time, crucified - on the cross He <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - took on Himself man's sin - bore the wrath of God - died in man's place - was raised from the dead <ul style="list-style-type: none"> = His sacrifice was accepted = sin's penalty was paid = God's just demands met = His wrath appeased - ascended into heaven - sat down at God's right hand - as High Priest He makes intercession for believers - saves all who call on His name in faith, repenting 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - in Jesus we saw the glory of God, full of grace and truth (John 1:14,18) - the glory of God is in the face of Christ (2 Cor. 4:6) - God forgives our sins for His name's sake (for His glory) (Ps. 79:9) - God saves to make His power known (Ps. 106:6-8) - prayers are answered that God may be glorified (John 14:13) - God predestined us according to His purpose and will to the praise of His glory (Eph. 1:5-6, 11-14) - to God be the glory forever (Rom. 11:33-36)

→ God does all things for His glory

→ so that the fullness of all that He is may be seen

→ so that He might be accurately esteemed, appropriately worshipped and abundantly enjoyed as God
