## I Conclusions about Spiritual Gifts

- 1. Just like every other believer, you have been given at least one spiritual gift
- 2. As a good steward, you will give an account to the Lord for the using of your gifts
- 3. Spiritual gifts are given ultimately so that God may be glorified (1 Pet 4:10-11; Rev 4:11; Col 1:16)
- 4. Spiritual gifts must be exercised in total conformity to biblical teaching
  - a) without love the gifts cannot achieve God's intended purpose → worthless
  - b) all gifts must be exercised properly and in an orderly manner (1 Cor 13:1-3, 14:39-40)
- 5. Your gifts are necessary for the good and the building up of the body, the church
- 6. As the body needs you, you need the body
- 7. Spiritual gifts are given to bless the church in the realm of the Spirit
  - $\rightarrow$  the sphere of relationship with God
  - → the deepest level of human existence and experience
  - → they strike right at the root of all human problems

- 8. God's plan and purpose for you was in place before you were born
  - a) He chose you in Jesus before the foundation of the world
  - b) He prepared beforehand your good works

- = to ordain before
- = to make ready in advance

2041 **ἔργον** ergon

- = business, undertaking, enterprise
- = the idea of working is emphasized
- c) at your salvation He outfitted you perfectly for this work with
  - the exact right spiritual gift(s)
  - the perfect measure of grace and faith
  - the Word to equip for every good work
    (Eph 1:4; 2:8-10; 2 Tim 3:16-17)
- 9. "The value of your life as a Christian will be determined by the degree to which you use the gift God has given you"

- Ray Stedman (Body Life)

- 10. You should not seek a gift God has determined your gifts
- 11. You should seek to discover your gifts

## II How to Recognize your Spiritual Gift

- 1. Pray and ask God to oepn your eyes and ears to His call on your life
- 2. You will be drawn to your gift and to other believers who have the same gift
- 3. Others will recognize your gifts in you
  - → ask trusted Christian friends what they see in you
- 4. You will be comfortable in the area of your gifting
- 5. You will be effective in exercising of your gifts
- 6. Consider that you may have spiritual gifts that will remain undiscovered until specific needs or circumstances bring them to light

## III You need to know your Spiritual Gift

- 1. Your gift will direct you to God's will and purpose for your life
- 2. Your gift will help you in setting priorities
- 3. Your gift will help you accept your place in the body of Christ, the church
- 4. Your gift identifies areas for further training and development
