

## DEATH OF THE APOSTLES AND CHURCH LEADERS ACCORDING TO TRADITION

1. JAMES (greater) - beheaded at Jerusalem (45 AD)
2. PETER - crucified in Rome with his head downward (64 AD)
3. ANDREW - hanged from an olive tree (70 AD)
4. BARTHOLOMEW - flayed alive
5. THOMAS - burned alive (70 AD)
6. PHILIP - crucified (54 AD)
7. MATTHEW - beheaded in a distant city of Ethiopia (65 AD)
8. NATHANAEL - crucified (70 AD)
9. JAMES (lesser) - thrown from a pinnacle of the temple and then beaten to death with a fuller's club (63 AD)
10. SIMON - crucified (74 AD)
11. JUDAS THADDEUS - beaten with sticks (72 AD)
12. MATTHIAS - stoned on a cross and then beheaded (70 AD)
13. JOHN - put in a cauldron of boiling oil but escaped by a miracle – later banished to the Island of Patmos where he died a natural death (95 AD)
14. PAUL - after various tortures and persecutions, beheaded at Rome (69 AD)
15. MARK - died after being dragged through the streets of Alexandria
16. LUKE - hanged on an olive tree in Greece
17. JUDE - shot to death by arrows
18. BARNABAS - stoned to death at Salonica
