ELDER Qualifications – Part 1

- 1. The leadership of any church determines the spiritual growth and wellbeing of its members
 - → it is crucial that every elder of every church be the one that God has called, gifted and foreordained for that specific place and ministry
- 2. The one called by the Lord Jesus to lead and oversee a local church
 - will <u>aspire</u> to the office of elder
 - #3713 ὀρέγω oregomai
 - = to stretch one's self out in order to touch or grasp something
 - = to strive to attain, to long after
 - = to be ambitious for
 - in 1 Timothy 3:1 this verb is in the middle voice → God is in his aspiring
- 3. His ambition is a mature and godly aspiring:
 - a) it is free of selfishness, seeking only the glory of God and the good of others
 - b) it does not seek position, praise, power, prestige or popularity but service to God
 - c) it has at its heart the GLORIFICATION of God, the BUILDING UP of the church and the EVANGELIZING of the lost

- The list of qualifications that an elder must demonstrate is long and it takes into account every area of life
 - \rightarrow in all things he is to be <u>above reproach</u>
 - #S423 ἀνεπίλημπτος anepileptos (1T) = not open to blame, above criticism
 - = having nothing on which an adversary could base a charge
 - **#410** ἀνέγκλητος anegkletos (T) = blameless, free from accusation
 - → this indicates a general maturity, <u>not</u> perfection with no room for growth (Phil 3:10-14)
- The sought after qualities can be seen in a potential elder's most basic relationships

A. TO GOD AND THE SCRIPTURE

- 1) not a new convert
 - \rightarrow not one who has recently been saved
 - \rightarrow does he truly know the Lord?
 - → has he demonstrated a growing spiritual maturity?
- 2) devout
 - #3741 ὄσιος hosios
 - = holy, undefiled by sin
 - = observing every moral obligation
 - → does he show an active commitment to know, love and serve God?

3) holding fast the faithful word

#472 ἀντέχω antechomai

- = to cling to, to cleave firmly to
- \rightarrow is he a diligent student of the Word?

able to teach

- → does he know the Word well enough to be able to teach it to others?
 - to exhort in sound doctrine?
 - to refute those who contradict?

B. TO HIS FAMILY AND HOUSEHOLD

1) the husband of one wife

- \rightarrow is he a one woman man?
- → is he totally devoted and faithful to his own wife?
- able to manage his own household well
 #4291 προϊστημι proistemi
 - = to superintend, preside over
 - = to guide, lead, direct
 - a) his wife must be dignified, not a malicious gossip, temperate, faithful in all things (1 Tim 3:11)
 - b) he must have believing and obedient children whom he keeps under control with dignity
 - → his home and family life will indicate how well he will be able to take care of the church of God
