### \* DEACONS

#### #1249 διάκονος diakonos

- = one executing the commands of another
- = one entrusted to serve the needs of believers = an office in the church
  - → they "serve" the elders freeing them up to prayer and ministry of the Word
  - → they hold no ruling authority

# They must first be tested

## #1381 δοκιμάζω dokimazo

- = to test, examine, prove, scrutinize
- = to judge as good or worthy, to approve
  - → to see if they are above reproach

# Their qualifications → they must be

- a) people of dignity (also deaconesses)#4586 σεμνός semnos
  - = grave, honest, honorable, worthy of respect, noble
- b) not double-tongued

# #1351 δίλογος dilogos

- = hypocritical, insincere, two-faced
- c) not addicted to much wine (deaconesses)
- d) not fond of sordid gain
- e) holding to the mystery of faith with a clear conscience (deaconesses)
- f) husbands of one wife
- g) good managers of their children and households
- h) not malicious gossips (Acts 6:1-4; 1 Ti 3:8-13)

#### \* MEN

- 1. Older men are to be:
  - 3524 temperate
  - 4586 dignified
  - 4998 sensible
  - 5198 sound in faith, love & perseverance
- 2. Younger men are to be:
  - 4993 sensible
    - = to put a moderate estimate on oneself
    - = to think of oneself soberly
  - 2570 / 2041 doing good deeds
  - 90 / 1319 pure in doctrine
  - 4586 dignified
  - 5199 sound in speech beyond reproach

#### \* WOMEN

- 1. Older women are to be:
  - 2412 reverent in behaviour
  - 1228 not malicious gossips
  - 1402 not enslaved to much wine
  - 2567 teachers of goodness
    - → training the young women
- 2. Young women are to be:
  - 4998 sensible
  - 53 pure = chaste, modest, clean
  - 18 kind

# **\*** SLAVES AND MASTERS

Slaves must be obedient to their masters; Masters are to be just and fair to their slaves (1 Tim 6:1-2; Eph 6:5-9; Col 3:22-4:1; 1 Pet 2:18-20)

#### \* FAMILIES

- 1. Husbands are to
  - love their wives as Christ did the church
  - nourish and cherish their wives as they love and care for themselves
- 2. Fathers are to
  - bring up their children in the discipline and instruction of the Lord
  - not provoke their children to anger
  - not exasperate their children so they will not lose heart
- 3. Wives are to
  - be subject to their own husbands as the church is subject to Christ
  - love their husbands
  - 5399 respect their husbands
    - = to treat with deference
  - love their children
  - 3626 be workers at home
    - = to care for or keep a house
  - 3616 oikodespoteo to keep house
    - = to be master of a house; to rule a household
- 4. Children are to obey their parents in all things in the Lord
- 5. Families are to provide for and take care of their own
