The Holy Spirit and the Church

Acts 2:1-4

1. When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place.
2. And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.
3. And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them.
4. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance.

Acts 2:17

‘AND IT SHALL BE IN THE LAST DAYS,’ God says, ‘THAT I WILL POUR FORTH OF MY SPIRIT ON ALL MANKIND; AND YOUR SONS AND YOUR DAUGHTERS SHALL PROPHECY, AND YOUR YOUNG MEN SHALL SEE VISIONS, AND YOUR OLD MEN SHALL DREAM DREAMS;

John 14:16

I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever;

John 15:26

When the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, *that is* the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify about Me,

John 16:7

But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.

Matthew 16:18

I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it.

1 Corinthians 12:13

For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

1 Corinthians 3:16-17

16. Do you not know that you are a temple of God and *that* the Spirit of God dwells in you?
17. If any man destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, and that is what you are.

... in whom (*Jesus Christ*) you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

Acts 13:2

Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

1 Thessalonians 1:5

... for our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; just as you know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.

1 Peter 1:12

It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves, but you, in these things which now have been announced to you through those who preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things into which angels long to look.

Revelation 2:7a

He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. ...

Ephesians 5:18-19

18. And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit,
19. speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord;

Ephesians 6:18

With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints,

Ephesians 4:3

... being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

1 Corinthians 12

Acts 13:2-4

2. While they were ministering to the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."
3. Then, when they had fasted and prayed and laid their hands on them, they sent them away.
4. So, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went down to Seleucia and from there they sailed to Cyprus.

Acts 16:6-7

6. They passed through the Phrygian and Galatian region, having been forbidden by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in Asia;
7. and after they came to Mysia, they were trying to go into Bithynia, and the Spirit of Jesus did not permit them;

Acts 15:24-29

24. "Since we have heard that some of our number to whom we gave no instruction have disturbed you with *their* words, unsettling your souls,
25. it seemed good to us, having become of one mind, to select men to send to you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul,
26. men who have risked their lives for the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
27. "Therefore we have sent Judas and Silas, who themselves will also report the same things by word *of mouth*.
28. "For it seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us to lay upon you no greater burden than these essentials:
29. that you abstain from things sacrificed to idols and from blood and from things strangled and from fornication; if you keep yourselves free from such things, you will do well. Farewell."

Acts 13:50-52

50. But the Jews incited the devout women of prominence and the leading men of the city, and instigated a persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and drove them out of their district.
51. But they shook off the dust of their feet *in protest* against them and went to Iconium.
52. And the disciples were continually filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

A 1	<p><u>John 16:8-11</u></p> <p>8. "And He, when He comes, will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment; 9. concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me; 10. and concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father and you no longer see Me; 11. and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.</p>
A 2	<p><u>Acts 5:30-32</u></p> <p>30. "The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you had put to death by hanging Him on a cross. 31. "He is the one whom God exalted to His right hand as a Prince and a Savior, to grant repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. 32. "And we are witnesses of these things; and <i>so is</i> the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey Him."</p> <p><u>John 15:26-27</u></p> <p>26. "When the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, <i>that is</i> the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify about Me, 27. and you <i>will</i> testify also, because you have been with Me from the beginning.</p>
B1	<p><u>John 3:8</u></p> <p>"The wind blows where it wishes and you hear the sound of it, but do not know where it comes from and where it is going; so is everyone who is born of the Spirit."</p> <p><u>Titus 3:5</u></p> <p>He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,</p> <p><u>Romans 8:2</u></p> <p>For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death.</p>
B2	<p><u>1 Corinthians 12:13</u></p> <p>For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.</p> <p><u>Acts 1:5</u></p> <p>... for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."</p> <p><u>Acts 11:15-16</u></p> <p>15. "And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them just as <i>He did</i> upon us at the beginning. 16. "And I remembered the word of the Lord, how He used to say, 'John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.'</p>

B3	<p><u>Philippians 2:1</u> Therefore if there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and compassion,</p> <p><u>2 Corinthians 13:14</u> The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit, be with you all.</p>
B4	<p><u>2 Thessalonians 2:13</u> But we should always give thanks to God for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth.</p> <p><u>Romans 1:4</u> ... who was declared the Son of God with power by the resurrection from the dead, according to the Spirit of holiness, Jesus Christ our Lord,</p>
B5	<p><u>John 14:16-17</u> 16. "I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever; 17. <i>that is</i> the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, <i>but</i> you know Him because He abides with you and will be in you.</p> <p><u>1 Corinthians 6:19</u> Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?</p> <p><u>1 Corinthians 3:16</u> Do you not know that you are a temple of God and <i>that</i> the Spirit of God dwells in you?</p> <p><u>Romans 8:9</u> However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.</p> <p><u>Galatians 4:6</u> Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"</p> <p><u>Romans 8:14-16</u> 14. For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. 15. For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" 16. The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God,</p>

B6	<p><u>Ephesians 1:13-14</u> 13. In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, 14. who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of <i>God's own</i> possession, to the praise of His glory.</p> <p><u>2 Corinthians 1:22</u> ... who also sealed us and gave <i>us</i> the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge.</p> <p><u>2 Corinthians 5:5</u> Now He who prepared us for this very purpose is God, who gave to us the Spirit as a pledge.</p> <p><u>Revelation 7:3</u> ... saying, "Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees until we have sealed the bond-servants of our God on their foreheads."</p>
B7	<p><u>1 Corinthians 12:8-11</u> 8. For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of knowledge according to the same Spirit; 9. to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, 10. and to another the effecting of miracles, and to another prophecy, and to another the distinguishing of spirits, to another <i>various</i> kinds of tongues, and to another the interpretation of tongues. 11. But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills.</p> <p><u>Hebrews 10:29</u> How much severer punishment do you think he will deserve who has trampled under foot the Son of God, and has regarded as unclean the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has insulted the Spirit of grace?</p>
