Romans 10:14, 17

14. How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed? How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher?

17. So faith *comes* from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

Galatians 3:2

This is the only thing I want to find out from you: did you receive the Spirit by the works of the Law, or by hearing with faith?

Mark 1:14-15

- 14. Now after John had been taken into custody, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of God,
- 15. and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."

Acts 14:15

... and saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We are also men of the same nature as you, and preach the gospel to you that you should turn from these vain things to a living God, WHO MADE THE HEAVEN AND THE EARTH AND THE SEA AND ALL THAT IS IN THEM.

... dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.

What must I believe?

Romans 1:16

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Ephesians 1:13

In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise,

Philippians 1:27

Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;

Romans 10:9

... that if you confess with your mouth Jesus *as* Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved;

John 3:16

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

John 3:36

"He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

Acts 10:43

"Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins."

Romans 3:28

For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from works of the Law.

2 Timothy 1:9

(*God*) who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity,

- 5. He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will,

- 7. In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

1 Peter 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

Luke 1:77-78

- 77. To give to His people *the* knowledge of salvation by the forgiveness of their sins,
- 78. Because of the tender mercy of our God, with which the Sunrise from on high will visit us,

Ephesians 2:4-5

- 4. But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,
- 5. even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),

John 3:16

- 21. But now apart from the Law *the* righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets,
- 22. even *the* righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction;
- 23. for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
- 24. being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

Galatians 3:26-28

- 26. For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.
- 27. For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.
- 28. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

Titus 2:11

For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men,

1 Chronicles 16:23

Sing to the LORD, all the earth; proclaim good tidings of His salvation from day to day.

For thus says the Lord God, "Behold, I Myself will search for My sheep and seek them out.

- 68. Blessed *be* the Lord God of Israel, for He has visited us and accomplished redemption for His people,

- 6. "In His days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely; and this is His name by which He will be called, 'The LORD our righteousness.'

Matthew 1:21

b) "She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

Philippians 3:20-21

- 20. For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ;
- 21. who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself.

John 3:5-6

- 5. Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- 6. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

- 37. "And the Father who sent Me, He has testified of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time nor seen His form.
- 38. "You do not have His word abiding in you, for you do not believe Him whom He sent.
- 39. "You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; it is these that testify about Me;
- 40. and you are unwilling to come to Me so that you may have life.

Romans 1:18-19

- 18. For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,
- 19. because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them.
