| 5 | <u>Romans 4:18-21</u> 18. In hope against hope he believed, so that he might become a father of many nations according to that which had been spoken, "SO SHALL YOUR DESCENDANTS BE." 19. Without becoming weak in faith he contemplated his own body, now as good as dead since he was about a hundred years old, and the deadness of Sarah's womb; 20. yet, with respect to the promise of God, he did not waver in unbelief but grew strong in faith, giving glory to God, 21. and being fully assured that what God had promised, He was able also to perform. |
| 6 | <u>Hebrews 11:17-19</u> 17. He considered that God is able to raise <i>people</i> even from the dead, from which he also received him back as a type. |

- 3. For through the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as God has allotted to each a measure of faith.
- 4. For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function,
- 5. so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.
- 6. Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, *each of us is to exercise them accordingly:* if prophecy, according to the proportion of his faith;

Romans 14:1-5, 10

- 1. Now accept the one who is weak in faith, *but* not for *the purpose of* passing judgment on his opinions.
- 2. One person has faith that he may eat all things, but he who is weak eats vegetables *only*.
- 3. The one who eats is not to regard with contempt the one who does not eat, and the one who does not eat is not to judge the one who eats, for God has accepted him.
- 4. Who are you to judge the servant of another? To his own master he stands or falls; and he will stand, for the Lord is able to make him stand.
- 5. One person regards one day above another, another regards every day *alike*. Each person must be fully convinced in his own mind.
- 10. But you, why do you judge your brother? Or you again, why do you regard your brother with contempt? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God.
