Regeneration: Born Again Pt 2

What is Regeneration?

Matthew 28:18

And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

a) <u>Acts 2:36</u>

"Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ—this Jesus whom you crucified."

<u>John 18:36</u>

Jesus answered, "My kingdom is not of this world. If My kingdom were of this world, then My servants would be fighting so that I would not be handed over to the Jews; but as it is, My kingdom is not of this realm."

b) <u>Luke 17:20-21</u>

- 20. Now having been questioned by the Pharisees as to when the kingdom of God was coming, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God is not coming with signs to be observed;
- 21. nor will they say, 'Look, here *it is!*' or, 'There *it is!*' For behold, the kingdom of God is in your midst."

4	 <u>1 John 2:28-29</u> 28. Now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming. 29. If you know that He is righteous, you know that everyone also who practices righteousness is born of Him. <u>John 5:21</u> For just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, even so the Son also gives life to whom He wishes.
5	 John 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. John 3:8 "The wind blows where it wishes and you hear the sound of it, but do not know where it comes from and where it is going; so is everyone who is born of the Spirit." John 20:22 And when He had said this, He breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Genesis 2:7 Then the Lord God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being. Genesis 5:1-4 This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day when God created man, He made him in the likeness of God. He created them male and female, and He blessed them and named them Man in the day when they were created. When Adam had lived one hundred and thirty years, he became the father of <i>a son</i> in his own likeness, according to his image, and named him Seth. 7	 <u>2 Corinthians 4:10-11</u> 10. always carrying about in the body the dying of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body. 11. For we who live are constantly being delivered over to death for Jesus' sake, so that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh. <u>Ephesians 4:18</u> being darkened in their understanding, excluded from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their heart; <u>John 5:24</u> Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life. <u>Colossians 3:3</u> For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God.
8	<u>1 John 3:9</u> No one who is born of God practices sin, because His seed abides in him; and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.
9	 <u>2 Peter 1:4</u> For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of <i>the</i> divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust. <u>1 John 3:2</u> Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is.
12	 Philippians 1:6 For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus. Romans 8:38-39 38. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, 39. nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. 1 John 5:18 We know that no one who is born of God sins; but He who was born of God keeps him, and the evil one does not touch him.
